6. Recognition of City Staff

Executive Summary: On June 25, 2021, a Community Center patron, Lee Caryer, collapsed on the walking track on the fitness floor and was unresponsive. The fast actions of the Community Center staff saved Mr. Caryer's life. The team notified 911, started CPR, and deployed an AED before EMS arrived. When care was transferred to the paramedics with our Division of Fire and EMS, Mr. Caryer was starting to breathe again. Our paramedics continued Advanced Life Support while en route to the hospital, where definitive care was provided. Mr. Caryer has since returned to working out at the Community Center and has had an opportunity to meet many of the staff involved and share his full story and appreciation. At Monday's Council Meeting, we would like to introduce Mr. Caryer to City Council and recognize the staff involved in the response to his life threatening situation.
